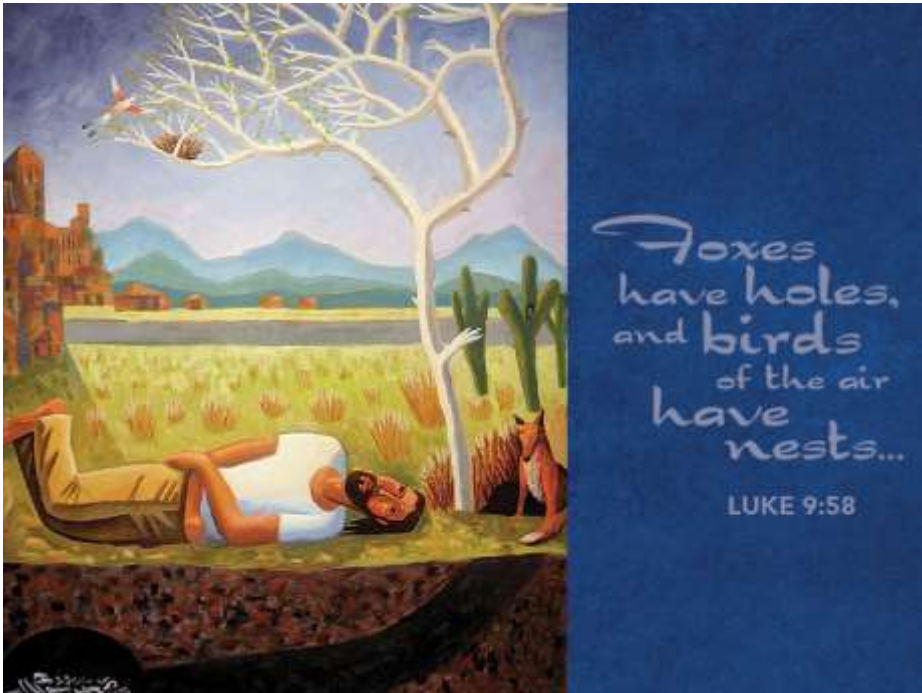

LESSON: 2 Kings 2:1-14

Elijah’s ministry is finished as he is taken up into heaven, and a new chapter begins as Elisha inherits the mantle and the spirit of his teacher. Like the great prophet Moses before them, both Elijah and Elisha part a body of water through the power of God.

PSALM 16L ¹Protect me, O God, for I take refuge in you;
I have said to the LORD, “You are my Lord, my good above all other.”C ²**All my delight is in the godly that are in the land,
upon those who are noble among the people.**L ³But those who run after other gods shall have their troubles multiplied.C ⁴**I will not pour out drink offerings to such gods,
never take their names upon my lips.**L ⁵O LORD, you are my portion and my cup; it is you who uphold my lot.C ⁶**My boundaries enclose a pleasant land; indeed, I have a rich inheritance.**L ⁷I will bless the LORD who gives me counsel;
my heart teaches me night after night.C ⁸**I have set the LORD always before me;
because God is at my right hand, I shall not be shaken.**L ⁹My heart, therefore, is glad, and my spirit rejoices;
my body also shall rest in hope.C ¹⁰**For you will not abandon me to the grave, nor let your holy one see the pit.**L ¹¹You will show me the path of life; in your presence there is fullness of joy,
and in your right hand are pleasures forevermore.

LESSON: Galatians 5:1, 13-25

For Paul, the freedom Christ gives is not permission to do whatever we want. It is the invitation to be what we could not be otherwise. The power and guidance of Christ's Holy Spirit produce a different kind of life, one marked by the fruit of this Holy Spirit.
