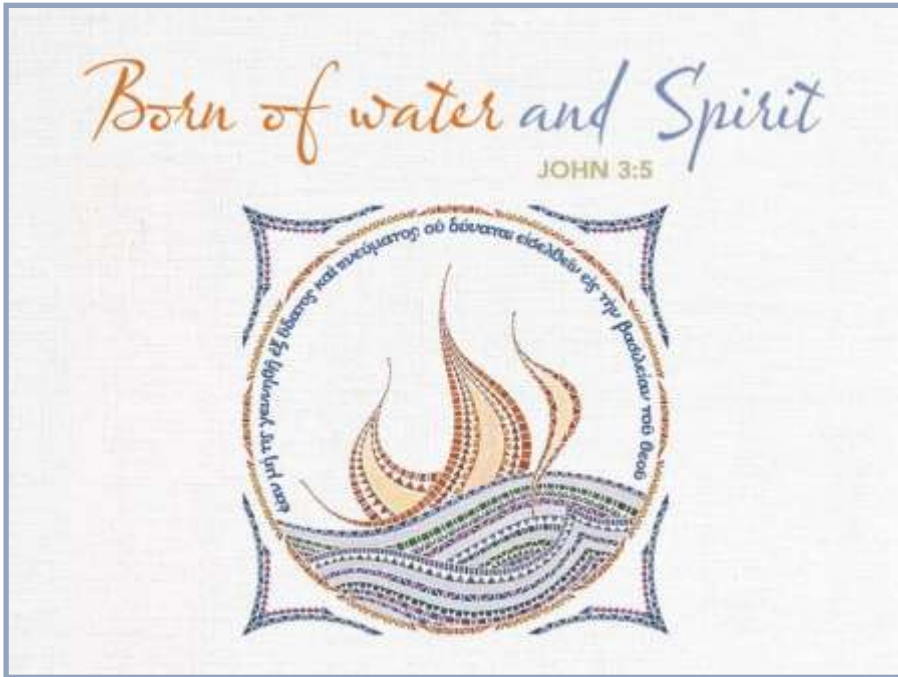

### MEMORIAL DAY LITANY AND PRAYER

**OPENING HYMN**                    “Eternal Father, Strong to Save”

Forgive us our failings, restore us to strength,  
and reconcile us with you, ourselves, and each other,  
through the power of Christ and the gift of your Spirit. Amen.**

P Sisters and brothers, hear the good news:  
We did not receive the spirit of slavery, but rather  
the spirit of adoption. *Rom. 8:15*  
Your guilt has departed; your sin is blotted out, *Isa. 6:7*  
for you are God's beloved children—forgiven, loved, and free. Amen.

## READING: Isaiah 6:1-8

*This reading narrates Isaiah's vision of the Lord surrounded by angels. This liturgical text invites the church and all creation to sing in praise of God's glory. That glory is God's mercy toward sinners.*

## PSALM 29

- L <sup>1</sup>Ascribe to the LORD, you gods,  
ascribe to the LORD glory and strength.
- C <sup>2</sup>**Ascribe to the LORD the glory due God's name;  
worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness.**
- L <sup>3</sup>The voice of the LORD is upon the waters; the God of glory thunders;  
the LORD is upon the mighty waters.
- C <sup>4</sup>**The voice of the LORD is a powerful voice;  
the voice of the LORD is a voice of splendor.**
- L <sup>5</sup>The voice of the LORD breaks the cedar trees;  
the LORD breaks the cedars of Lebanon;
- C <sup>6</sup>**the LORD makes Lebanon skip like a calf,  
and Mount Hermon like a young wild ox.**
- L <sup>7</sup>The voice of the LORD  
bursts forth in lightning flashes.
- C <sup>8</sup>**The voice of the LORD shakes the wilderness;  
the LORD shakes the wilderness of Kadesh.**
- L <sup>9</sup>The voice of the LORD makes the oak trees writhe and strips the forests bare.  
And in the temple of the LORD all are crying, "Glory!"
- C <sup>10</sup>**The LORD sits enthroned above the flood;  
the LORD sits enthroned as king forevermore.**
- L <sup>11</sup>O LORD, give strength to your people;  
give them, O LORD, the blessings of peace.

## READING: Romans 8:12-17

*In describing the new life of faith, Paul refers to all three persons of the Trinity: the Spirit leads us to recognize that we are children of God the Father and joint heirs with Christ the Son.*

## GOSPEL ACCLAMATION

*Jesus' miracles prompt Nicodemus to visit him in secrecy. Jesus tells him about being born of the Spirit and about the Son who has been sent by God to save.*
